Last year we started getting requests from Homeowners for a replacement spring for their mailbox door. The spring had broken and the door would not stay closed. The mailbox was made by Hanover Lantern but the company went out of business and a replacement spring was not available. Board members checked with many spring manufactures for a replacement spring but none were available. The board decided to have a replacement spring made for our mailboxes and had them manufactured for our association.

We had the springs made and have replaced two homeowner's broken springs and they work great. Our Association now has a supply of replacement springs for those who need one. We are requesting **\$10** for the spring to cover the cost of having them manufactured. You only need one spring to fix your mailbox. The old mailbox had two springs and the newer style has only one, we had the new style made so the work on both styles of mailbox. If a spring is needed I have the springs available and Bill Wertz our President has them available also. See the attachment for instructions on how to install the spring on both styles of the mailbox. Please save this information if you ever need a replacement spring.
